Having taken into account the conditions as arising from rainfall deficiency, decline in the availability of the ground and surface water, poor crop conditions, ascertained the distress situation that is likely to develop in the area affected by these conditions through crop field verification and on the basis of reports available from the Collector, Keonjhar, the State Government in continuation of earlier Notification No.6416/R&DM(DM), dated the 25th October, 2017 do hereby declare drought of moderate/ severe nature in an additional area of 55.00 hectares in 2 villages namely Tungurubahal and Saruali under Jagamohanpur Gram Panchayat of Telkoi Block of Keonjhar district.

The declaration of drought of moderate/severe nature in respect of the following 29 villages under Telkoi Block of Keonjhar district is de-notified, as the villages have not sustained crop loss of 33% and above as per the Crop cutting experiment.
