

Flood situation in Rayagada District

Dt.16.07.2017

Due to incessant rainfall on 15.07.2017, flash Floods occurred in river Nagabali and Kalyani of Rayagada district.

Damage to Roads & Bridges

Bridge washed away

- 1) Jula bridge of Binishpur near Jilunda
- 2) Railway bridge near Kartikguda
- 3) Railway Bridge between Therubali & Singapur Rd station
- 4) Bridge on Nahabali river on Antamada Denduli Therubali road
- 5) One Bailey bridge over Kalyani river 60 mtr

Flood water is flowing above the Rayagada – AP road.

Review Meeting

Two meetings were held under the chairmanship of the Development Commissioner at 1 PM & 5.00 P.M today (16.7.2017) in the State Emergency Operation Centre with the departments Secretaries in the office of Special Relief Commissioner to coordinate the response activities in the flash flood situation in Rayagada district.

Search & Rescue Operation

- Two ODRAF Teams, Fire Services and CRPF have been deployed for relief and rescue operation.
- Commandant, NDRF, Mundali has been requested to send 3 units of NDRF with equipment & boats to Rayagada .
- 12 persons from roof top in Ksinghpur tahasil, two persons of Chandili tree from top have been rescued by fire services.
- 2 persons have been rescued by ODRAF 3rd Btn. Koraput.
- Two pregnant women in labour pain were rescued by medical team. One safely delivered at K.Singhpur and another shifted to District Headquarter hospital.
- All persons from Nalabeta village rescued

Readiness for Air dropping of food packets into marooned areas

- Navy helicopter is standby at Vizag for relief operation tomorrow morning
- 2 Dornier aircraft standby at Bhubaneswar
- Four helicopters of IAF have been requisitioned for air dropping of food packets in the marooned areas.
- 3000 food packets are in readiness for air dropping. Packaging of food packets is being done at Rayagada Town Hall.

Emergent Food Assistance

- Collector, Rayagada has been instructed to provide 7 days' emergent food assistance.

Free Kitchen

- 10 places in Rayagada Block, free kitchen started for 685 people.
- 2 nos. of free kitchens have been opened at Majjihada High School and Kalyansinghpur ME School covering 1300 beneficiaries.
- Cooked food has been provided by CRPF for 400 persons at Kalyansinghpur
- 3 Industries have arranged food and relief materials which will be distributed tomorrow.

Health & Drinking Water Measures

- Food and drinking water has been arranged for 50 rescued people at CRPF camp Sheskhal.
- 6000 ltrs. of drinking water has been sent to Kalyansinghpur through tanker
- Medicines, bleaching powder, halogen tablets, salines, ORS, antisnake venoms has been sent to Rayagada and Kashipur for dispatch to Kalyansinghpur tomorrow.

Other Administrative Measures

- All neighboring districts of Rayagada have been instructed to provide the required manpower and material support to Rayagada district.
- All schools of Kalyansinghpur Block will remain closed.

Traffic Restoration

- Traffic allowed at 5.00p.m to ply over Nagavali overbridge at JKpur which was stopped temporarily on NH 326.Flood water receding
