Dt.18.07.2017 at 6.00 P.M.

1. Rayagada District

No heavy rainfall in Rayagada and Kalyansingpur Block since 17.07.2017

Damage to Roads & Bridges

Bridges washed away

- 1) Jula bridge of Binishpur near Jilunda
- 2) Railway bridge near Kartikguda
- 3) Railway Bridge between Therubali & Singapur RD station
- 4) Bridge on Nagabali river on Antamada Denduli Therubali road
- 5) One Bailey bridge over Kalyani river damaged

Road Damaged:

1. Kamtalpeta – Ksinghpur road SH-45 - restored temporarily and traffic allowed
2. Rayagada-Kerada road MDR 48 (B) - restored temporarily and traffic allowed
3. Kasipur- Thuamulrampur road
4. Rayagada – AP road.

Review Meeting

- The Development Commissioner has reviewed the situation with the Secretaries of the concerned Departments.
- The Special Relief Commissioner reviewed the situation to the line Departments at 10.30 AM on 17.7.2017 with line departments on measures taken to ameliorate the sufferings of flood victims.
- Hon'ble Chief Minister held video conference with the Collectors of the affected districts regarding relief and rescue operation.

Search & Rescue Operation

- Two ODRAF Teams, Fire Services units and CRPF have been deployed for relief and rescue operation.

- 12 persons from roof top in K.singhpur tahasil, two persons of Chandili from tree top have been rescued by fire services.
- 2 persons have been rescued by ODRAF 3rd Btn. Koraput.
- All affected people from village Nalabeta safely rescued

Air dropping of food packets in marooned areas

- 4.2 qntls. of dry food have been airdropped by Dronier Aircraft of Coast Guard today (18.07.2017) of Niyamagiri area of Rayagada district
- Naval helicopter has airdropped food packets in three sorties
- 1000 food packets have been airdropped in K.Singhpur and Majhiguda block
- 4000 food packets have been distributed by road.

Emergent Food Assistance

- Emergent food assistance is being distributed to the affected people as per the Norms and Guidelines of SDRF
- 179.55 Q. – Rice, 28.728 Q. – Dal, 71.30 Q. – Chuda, 13.60 Q. –Gud, 170 Box-Biscuits, 4120 nos. – Candel, 8400 nos. – Match box have been provided to 5166 nos. of beneficiaries.

Free Kitchen

- 59 persons including 19 children and a 15 day old male child sheltered in Gouda Bangitipada Primary School, Bhawanipatna free kitchen centre
- 10 free kitchen centres opened in Rayagada for 815 people.
- 5 free kitchen centres have been opened at Majhiguda High School and Kalyansinghpur ME School covering 1750 beneficiaries.

Health & Drinking Water Measures

- 10 Health Camps are functioning in Rayagada Block and 5 in Kalyansinghpur Block
- Medical Health Team deployed at Bairagi Haula Shelter with essential medicines, ORS, Halogen Tabs.
- Drinking water has been provided to Kalyansinghpur through tanker
- Medicines, bleaching powder, halogen tablets, salines, ORS, antsnake venoms has been sent to Rayagada and Kashipur for dispatch to Kalyansinghpur tomorrow.
- ORS and Halogen Tabs. supplied to ITDA residential schools
- 6 nos. of water tanker engaged
- 16000 water pouches distributed
- 4 bags bleaching powder used
- 29 drinking water sources disinfected

Veterinary Measures:

- 5 Rapid Response Team has been formed in Rayagad District to provide necessary veterinary services.
- 5 Mobile Veterinary Units in Rayagad District have been mobilized to organize veterinary health camps / De-worming camps in each affected villages.

- Adequate medicines, vaccines etc. are available in CDPOs
- 12 camps have been organized
- 591 animals have been treated
- CDVO have been instructed to ensure vaccination in the affected villages.

Other Administrative Measures

- All neighboring districts of Rayagada have been instructed to provide the required manpower and material support to Rayagada district.
- All schools of Kalyansinghpur, Rayagada, Kasipur Block have been closed.

2. Kalahandi District :

Due to heavy rain in Thuamulrampur, Kalampur, Koksara, Jaipatna, floods occurred in river Hati and Tel.

- Rail line at Rupa road of Narla Block submerged

Health & Drinking Water Measures

- 2 drinking water sources disinfected (tubewells)
- 3 pipe water sources damaged

Free Kitchen :

- Free kitchen provided to 384 persons in 8 relief camps

Search & Rescue:

- 2 ODRAF teams consisting 11 each deployed in Kalampur & Th.Rampur Block
- 17 persons rescued at village Taratikili of Bhawanipatna block

Veterinary Measures :

- 3 Mobile Veterinary Team deployed in to affected areas

Heavy Rain in Cuttack

154 MM rainfall has been experience today in Cuttack city. As a result, low lying areas have been submerged.

- 220 pump sets of CMC are in place for dewatering
- Water tankers and water pouches have been provided.
- RDC (CD) has reviewed the water logging situation

3. Malkanagiri District

Due to incessant rainfall in Kalimela and Padia Block of Malkanagiri district communication disrupted due to over topping of rain water.

1. Between Malkanigir and Kalimela at Kangrukonda
2. Between Kalimela and Podia at Kanyashrama

One child namely Rame Sodi, D/o Muya Sodi of village Sodigud under Motu Tahasil died due to wall collapse in Padia Block

Dule Sodi W/o Muya Sodi got head injury due to wall collapse and referred to DHH, Malkanagiri for treatment.

4. Nabarangpur District

One ODRAF Unit of 3rd Battalion, Koraput stationed at Nabarangpur for relief and rescue operation.

5. Cuttack District

Due to incessant rain from 16th July 43 locations under Cuttack Municipal Corporation have been water logged. 230 pump sets have been installed by CMC and additional 16 nos. of pump sets have been installed by Jica for drainage of water.

Except Sadar area, other areas of Cuttack district situation is normal.
